INVITED by Select Board Chairman to Start Energy Committee - June, '07.

INTRODUCED OUR COMMITTEE TO TOWN – 2007

- A. INITIATED CONTACT with **SELECT BOARD** for go-ahead to study PSNH energy/cost saving municipal lighting plans – July.
- B. CONNECTED with **HARVEST FESTIVAL COMMITTEE** – to provide energy conservation/educational booth at festival. Gave free CFLs, live demo all day. TEEC provided recycling for the Festival - Fall
- C. MET with **SELECT BOARD** for OK on installation of energy/cost saving upgrades for municipal lighting through Smart Start Program – Nov.

III. Slide 3 – “Float Like a Butterfly” – ‘08

Tone and tenor promoted community and a collegial atmosphere. We took extra care to remain nonpartisan.

IV. Slide 4 – Sprouting

EXTENDED CONTACTS WITH BOARDS AND TOWN COMMITTEES THROUGH INVENTORY WORK, AUDITS, AND TOWN EVENTS.

- A. CONNECTED WITH DEPT. HEADS, BOARD CHAIRMEN, MUNICIPAL ADMIN. STAFF to collect data for Municipal Energy Inventory - Spring
- B. MET with **SELECT BOARD** to suggest energy audits - Spring
- C. COORDINATED with **TOWN COMMITTEES**- float in 4th of July Parade, Harvest Fest booth, provided major assistance for Good Roads Day – Spring/Summer/Fall.
- D. PURCHASED recycling bins for all committees to use for their own events.

E. PROVIDED recycling service for **Town Meeting, Good Roads Day, Half-Marathon, July 4th Celebration, Harvest Festival**

F. INVITED **SELECT BOARD** to auditor's presentation of Report on Municipal Energy Audits – Fall.

C. ARRANGED JOINT MEETING with **PLANNING BOARD** for presentation of Draft Report from Energy Audit of Master Plan/Zoning Ordinances. Board agreed to more joint meetings – Dec.

D. REQUESTED MEETING with **SELECT BOARD** to present Energy Committee's recommendations for '09 retrofitting projects, based on inventory assessment and audit reports. All were approved, but no funding available! - Jan.

E. HELD TWO JOINT MEETINGS with **PLANNING BOARD** for follow through on Master Plan/Zoning Ordinance audit – Spring.

F. WORKED with **SELECT BOARD, TOWN HALL COMM, FD, MUNICIPAL STAFF, LIBRARY TRUSTEES** for municipal retrofit estimates for RGGI Grant proposal - Spring.
